Called to order by Mahoney at 4:30 pm. Minutes of the 7/7/20 meeting were reviewed and approved by a roll call vote (2 in favor, 1 abstention (Dutton)). Ms. Mahoney opened the meeting by reading "A Checklist to Ensure Meetings Are Compliant with The Right-To-Know Law during the State of Emergency."

Ms. Mahoney welcomed Ms. Dutton to the committee.

Dr. Haynes and administrators presented remote learning plans for each building and special education, in advance of the presentation to the board later that evening. They clarified that Friday was chosen as the flex day to preserve continuity from Monday-Thursday, and because some professional development will occur on Fridays due to trainers' availability. Ms. Dutton stressed the importance of consistent start times and the ability of teachers to respond to requests for assistance in a timely manner. Mr. Fitzpatrick stressed the importance for staff to work from the buildings, for effective collaboration.

Dr. Haynes reviewed the standardized tests which will be administered in order to evaluate student performance, in the absence of test data from last year.
