

# **EISA Subcommittee Agenda 10/21/20, 4:30 - 5:30 pm**

### **Draft of 9/16/20 minutes**

In attendance: Chair Tammy Mahoney, Jamie Fitzpatrick, Dawn Dutton, Director of Teaching and Learning Patty Haynes, Secondary Math Coordinator Grace Evans. Called to order by Mahoney at 4:30 pm. Minutes of the 8/17/20 meeting were reviewed and unanimously approved by a roll call vote. Ms. Mahoney opened the meeting by reading “A Checklist to Ensure Meetings Are Compliant with The Right-To-Know Law during the State of Emergency.”

Ms. Evans discussed her progress in assessing the math programs at the middle and high schools. Her initial efforts have centered on meeting the staff and observing classes. She’s been pleased with the reception from the teachers, who have been eager to discuss student learning, and she believes that the teachers are committed and engaged.

Dr. Hayes reported on the Alma implementation. The backend work is being finalized and training was conducted on 8/26 and 27. The response from the training has been positive. The initial rollout will be in grades 7-12, while K-6 focus more on the groundwork for remote learning. It is expected to be live for parents soon.

Dr. Haynes also reported on the upcoming assessments. Because statewide assessments weren’t conducted last Spring, the NHDOE is requiring districts to administer them in early October as a baseline. Students in grades 4-8 will take the Math and ELA SAS for their grade last year. The NWEA will be administered from oldest grades to youngest, starting around 10/13. The SAT will be administered to Seniors on 10/14 in-school.
