

SCHOOL BOARD ELECTIONS

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to describe the method of election, number and terms of office of members of the Sanborn Regional School Board.

The newly elected officers shall take office at the board meeting immediately following the tabulation and validation of official balloting by the town clerks. There shall be seven members of the school board of the Sanborn Regional School District. Each pre-existing district shall be entitled to three members. The seventh member shall be elected at large.

The School Board shall consist of an odd number of members elected by the qualified voters of the District at the annual District elections.

The term of office of each member of the School Board shall be for a period of three (3) years. Vacancies that occur before the expiration of a member's term shall be filled pursuant to Board policy BBBC. A member appointed to fill a vacancy shall serve only until the next annual election, at which point the seat will be open for election to serve the remainder of the original term.

Under RSA 189:1-c, and RSA 194:23-f, the Board may choose to add one or more non-voting student member(s) from a high school in the District to the Board. Elections for such student board members shall be held in accordance with RSA 194:23-f, and with the provisions of Policy BBBF.
