STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

Statement of Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to define the Student Health Services that will be offered by the Sanborn Regional School District.

Statement of Policy

The Sanborn Regional School District provides student health services in order to appraise, protect, and promote student health. These services are designed to provide access and/or referral to primary health care services, to prevent and control communicable disease and other health problems, and to provide emergency care for illness or injury. These services are provided by a Registered Nurse (the School Nurse), who is responsible for the following components of the health services program:

1. Identification, assessment, planning, intervention, and evaluation of student health concerns, including illnesses and injuries.
2. Maintenance of a school health record, which includes at least appropriate health history, immunization status, allergies, medication history and use, and other pertinent health information.
3. Screening for health factors impacting student education.
4. Promote student health and safety.
5. Management, education and coordination of chronic diseases and conditions.
6. Development and implementation of individualized nursing care plans and services for students with disabilities and/or health conditions that interfere with student learning.
7. Administration of medications.
8. Communication of health-related observations, assessments, and findings to parents/guardians, appropriate school staff, and/or outside health providers.
9. Identification of individual and aggregate health and/or safety risks and recommendations to minimize or eliminate those risks.
10. Participation in the development and implementation of the health education curriculum.
11. Provision of input to District health policies, goals, and objectives.
